- training in cooperation with partner institutions (e.g. Czech Bar Association, Association of Judges, Association of Prosecutors, Chamber of Court Appointed Interpreters and Translators);
- training in cooperation with state authorities and institutions (E.g. Probation and Mediation Service, Prison Service, Ministry of the Interior, Office of the Public Defender of Rights, Constitutional Court);
- training and judicial exchanges in cooperation with European training institutions (active membership in the European Judicial training Network, EJTN);

- **Start of the project – Project Agreement between the Ministry of Finance of the Czech Republic and the Norway Ministry of Foreign Affairs – concluded on March 6, 2008**
- **Ministry of Justice of the Czech Republic – project beneficiary**
- **Judicial Academy – project coordinator (project management, technical, methodological and organizational coordination)**
- **Net University – JA partner (+Distance Learning Centre of the Faculty of Law of Palacký University in Olomouc – methodology of distance and blended learning, software for the project)**

# MAIN OUTCOMES OF THE PROJECT

- **Virtual learning environment - Learning Management System (LMS) Unifor**
  - **one functional (seamless) platform - JA websites <http://www.jacz.cz/> interconnected with JA electronic database systems**
  - **Possibility to access e-learning study texts either from JA main webpage or separately in LMS Unifor on <http://unifor.jacz.cz/> or through JA registration system ASJA on <http://asja.jacz.cz>**
- **Modernization of training system in the Czech judiciary by strengthening of distance character of training with the use of modern training technologies and methods (distance and blended learning)**
  - **52 authors trained to work and write in LMS Unifor**
  - **15 pilot study modules for pilot training in form of blended learning**
  - **110 study modules (104+6 manuals) as e-learning part of courses offered at the JA in form of distance and blended learning**



# WHY A PROJECT ON E-LEARNING TRAINING?

- **Based on thorough needs analysis of methods preferred by participants of training from the judicial sector and on e-justice concept**
- **Compatible with modern European trends in adult training**
- **Combination of distance and face-to-face methods of training brings advantages because it enables:**
  - **Study anytime from anywhere (distance learning)**
  - **Standardization of theoretical knowledge**
  - **Development of practical skills (more time for solving cases and related practical issues in face-to-face part of learning)**
  - **Effective training and saving money**

# PILOT TESTING

- 15 study modules used in blended learning courses (a blend of distance learning and face-to-face learning)
- LMS with modules enabled participants of training to study anytime from anywhere
- LMS enabled participants of training to communicate on-line with tutor (trainer)
- Blended learning method enabled in face-to-face part of training to shorten time spent on theoretical issues and to spend more time on training practical skills and discussing cases and examples from judicial practice
- Conclusions and suggestions for the future stages of project were made
